GUIDELINES

The Sussex Heritage Trust Awards are designed to recognise and reward high quality conservation, restoration and the good design of newly built projects and encourage the use of traditional skills and crafts.

CATEGORIES

- **Building Crafts**

An example of high-quality work by a craftsman or young apprentice using traditional skills or crafts.

The Award is given to the person rather than the project.

Sponsored by **Pilbeam Construction**

- **Commercial**

A non-residential project (e.g. shops, offices and industrial).

Sponsored by **Savills**

- **Ecclesiastical Building**

A restoration, repair, conversion or development scheme, which improves all, or part of an existing or former ecclesiastical building.

- **Landscape & Gardens**

A reclamation or improvement scheme in an urban or rural environment. *We recommend that planting be established before entering the project.*

- **Large Scale Residential**

A project of more than ten units.

- **Mid-Scale Residential**

A project of two to ten units.

- **Public and Community**

A project which provides or improves facilities for the community.

- **Small Scale Residential**

A project of one unit.

The recognition of one person's outstanding commitment to the heritage of Sussex.

- **The South Downs Design Award**

TIMETABLE

All projects must be fully completed within the past 3 years, except in the Landscape & Gardens category, which is up to 7 years.

Closing Date for Entries

Friday 26th March 2021

All submissions must be received by this date by email and post, with the following:

- A maximum of 6 before and after photographs
- Plans, restricted to a copy of the planning application and drawings as applicable
- A detailed Location Map and POST CODE of the project

The criteria include the project's suitability of purpose, the best use of the site, the quality of workmanship and suitability of materials used.

Judging Dates and Information

Wednesday 19th and

Thursday 20th May 2021

All submissions are judged by a team usually comprising a Sussex Heritage Trust Trustee, a professional in the appropriate field and a 'lay person' to ensure a balanced view. All are volunteers and receive no remuneration. Judging can only take place on the stated dates.

Winners of Awards receive a hand-crafted slate plaque, which is to be attached to the winning project. There may also be Highly Commended projects in any given category. There can be multiple Award winners and Highly Commended projects in any category.

All parties involved in the winning projects receive certificates. Awards are announced at the ceremony which are presented by the President of the Sussex Heritage Trust, The Rt Hon Lord Egremont DL.
